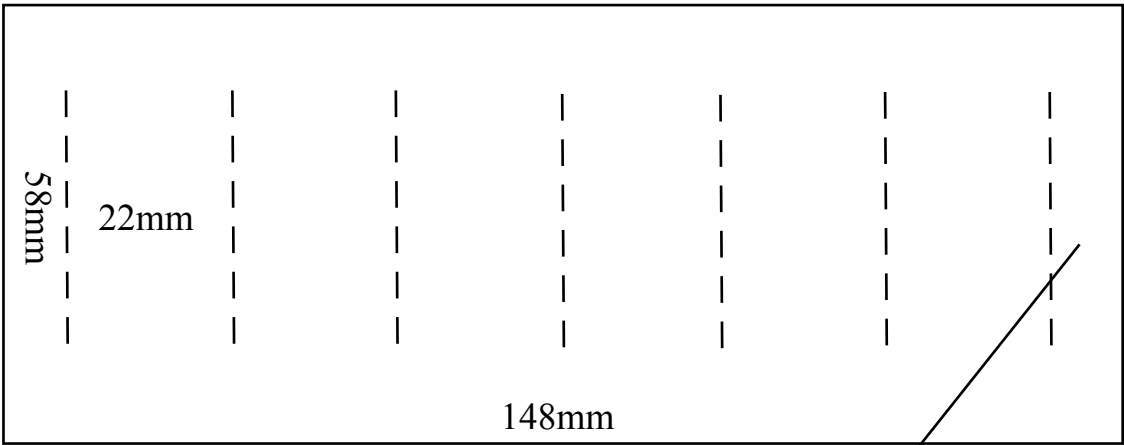
## Shotgun Cartridge Slider

### Instruction Sheet

This slider is designed to take six 58mmx20mm 12g Shotgun Cartridges.  
It is placed on A3 paper and if printed as such will be to scale.  
The design is very much open to adaptation and is mainly to give you the dimensions, stitch spacing and a good starting point.  
Please feel free to use adapt and share, but credit would be appreciated.

#### Plate Section

On the Plate Section, stitch rows are set 22mm apart and are centred between the top and bottom. Should a larger cartridge be used, the plate height may change but the placement remains the same.

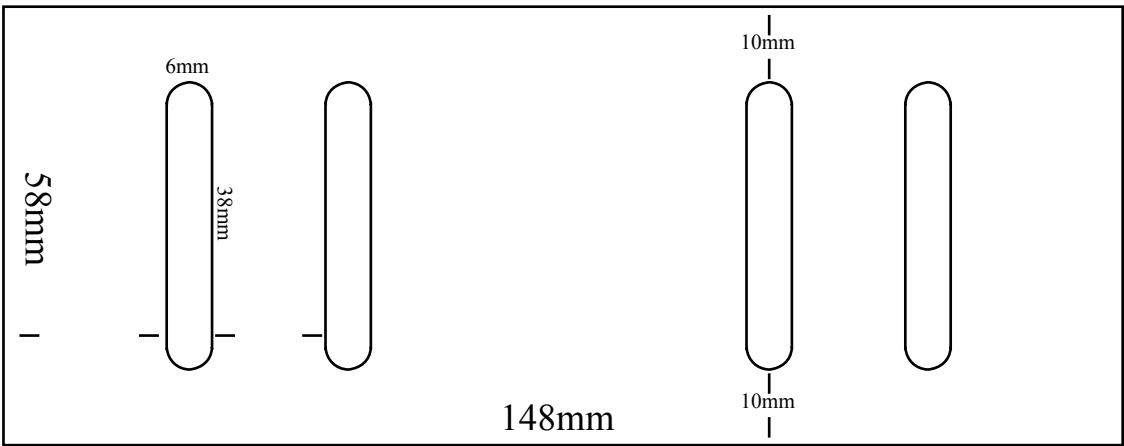


First and last stitch line will be 8mm from the end

**Filler:** I have added a third section of the same dimensions to sit between the Plate Section and the Belt Section. This will prevent wear on the threads where the belt passes from one row of stitching to the next.

#### Belt Section

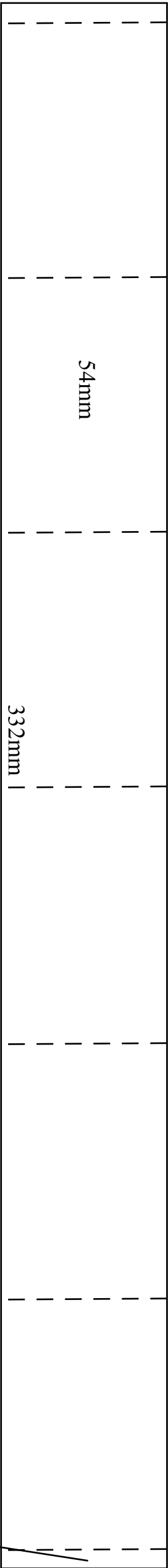
The belt section is the same size as the plate section.  
This is added to allow the plate to be slid onto a belt.  
A row of stitching can be added to the top and bottom allowing the belt to pass through the slide entirely, or slots can be added for the belt to pass through.  
Here, two sets of 1½ inch slots have been added with a crew punch. This allows the slider to be worn with a trouser belt and not have to exclude trouser loops.



Corners of both sections can be rounded if desired.

First and last stitch line will be 4mm from the end

#### Loop Section



The loop section has the stitching spaced 54mm apart, the idea being that once this is stitched to the plate section, loops form at the right size to take the cartridges. 10mm can be left at either end for a second row of stitching if desired. I have added 4mm as a return
